The Maricopa County Community College District's policies and procedures for responding to the COVID-19 pandemic are rooted in the safety of our students, faculty, staff, and community.

Title: **Keeping you Safe During In-Person Classes**

The health and wellbeing of our students, faculty, and staff is our number one priority. We have implemented the following actions to help ensure your safety when returning to campus this Fall.

Slide 4:

Title: **Wear a Face Covering**

A face covering must be worn by all students, faculty, and staff:

- While on campus and in the classroom
- Face coverings must be worn properly, covering both your nose and mouth
- Face coverings and social distancing are required at all times while on campus, and are not interchangeable of each other

Slide 5:

Title: **Practice Social/Physical Distancing**

Keeping space between yourself and others is one of the best tools we have to avoid being exposed to COVID-19 and helping slow its spread.

- Plastic barrier shields have been installed where needed
- Floor markings have been added to practice physical distancing and interact safely
- Classrooms have been rearranged, all tables and chairs are automatically separated by at least six feet

Slide 6:

Title: **Additional Campus Safety Measures**

- All classrooms will be disinfected daily
- Restrooms and common areas will be disinfected every two hours
- Follow directional signs on campus to minimize unnecessary contact with others
- Hand-sanitizer stations will be available in all restrooms, common areas, and classrooms
- When arriving on campus, students are encouraged to go directly to their classrooms and avoid congregating in large groups

Slide 7:

Title: **What you can do**

We encourage our students to follow these personal-safety best practices:

- Stay home if you are feeling sick
- Avoid touching your eyes and face
- Cough and sneeze into tissues or your elbow
- Wash your hands for a minimum of 20 seconds
- Report exposure and confirmed cases right away
- Minimize personal travel to known COVID-19 hotspots
- Carefully read and follow directional signage while on campus to minimize unnecessary contact with others
